

FOUNDATIONAL DOCTRINE – RESURRECTION **FROM THE DEAD**

Foundational doctrines – Heb 6:1-2

1. **Who will be resurrected?**

- Only those who die – 1 Cor 15:51-53
- Even if you are not dead at Christ's return your bodies will be changed by God's power.
- Everyone will face God's judgement – Heb 9:27, Rom 14:10

2. **It is the resurrection of the physical body**

- At death your body returns to dust – Eccl 3:20, 12:7
- At death we still retain our personality and conscience – Lk 16:19-24

3. **The resurrection**

- It was a doctrine in the Old Testament – Job 19:26, Psalm 16:10, Dan 12:2, Is 26:19
- It was a teaching of Jesus – Mt 8:11, Jhn 5:25,28-29

4. **The resurrection of Christ**

- Proof of His resurrection – Mat 28:9, Luke 24:15,36,39,41-46
1 Cor 15:4-8
- The importance of His resurrection – 1 Cor 15:13,14,16-19,21,22
- His resurrection declares His deity – Rom 1:4
- His resurrection declares certain judgment – Acts 17:31
- His resurrection declares the greatness of God's power available to us. – Eph 1:18-20

5. **The order of resurrections**

1. Christ (He is the first fruit) – 1 Cor 15:23
2. Christians – 1 Cor 15:23,52; 1 Thes 4:13-17
3. Those who are left – Dan 12:2, John 5:29, Rev 20:5,11-14

6. The nature of the resurrection of the Christians

- They will be glorified with Christ – Col 3:4, Phil 3:20-21, 1 John 3:2
- Their bodies will be –
 - Raised in incorruption – 1 Cor 15:42
 - Raised in glory and power – 1 Cor 15:43
 - Raised a spiritual body – 1 Cor 15:44
 - Bear the image of the heavenly – 1 Cor 15:49

7. The nature of the resurrection of the unbelievers

- They suffer shame and everlasting contempt – Dan 12:2
- They get resurrected to get damned – Jhn 5:29

8. The Christians great goal

- Attain the resurrection of the dead – Phil 3:11
- Get a heavenly body – 2 Cor 5:1-2
